It has been suggested that, in lieu of inviting a few literary agents to the conference, the WOTB board should consider a manuscript referral service for conference attendees.

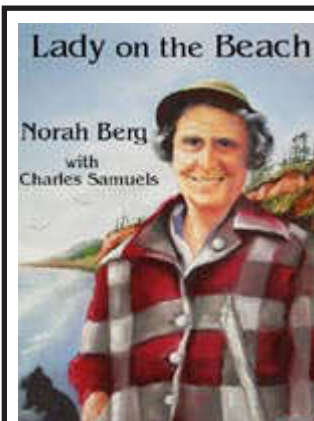
